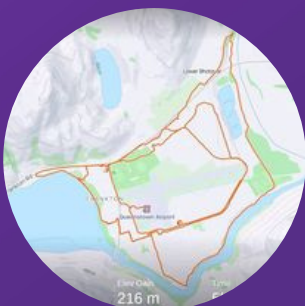


Most Creative Relay Idea
