# Aynsley Dermody, Cancer Navigator

I have been with the Cancer Society now for 5 years in the role of Cancer Navigator. Born and bred in Gore it has been nice to return to my local area in a Supportive Care role.

We have a variety of services available such as connecting you with other community service providers that can assist you in other aspects of your life during this time for example - counselling services, home help and personal care services, but often time to listen and discuss your individual and family situation and support needs is the most important. Helping to empower you to make informed decisions that are right for you and your family / whanau is important.

A major part of my role is assisting in arranging travel and accommodation. Travelling to appointments and treatment can be difficult and we can relieve a lot of stress by helping you know what financial subsidies are available through the Ministry of Health for travel and accommodation. Many people must travel to Dunedin for radiation treatment, and we have our "home away from home" Daffodil House accommodation or other choices available for those having to stay an extended time.

Gore has an amazing Support Group for anyone living with cancer, and or their carer. Some members may be newly diagnosed while others may be undergoing treatment or have finished treatment. We meet on the last Wednesday of each month at the Gore District Library for morning tea and a chat. Often, we have guest speakers but most of all it is about providing support for each other. I pay tribute to our amazing Cancer Society volunteers who are enthusiastically provide support through assisting with supporting you and our fundraising efforts.

Our services are free and confidential. I am available to make sure those people with cancer in the Gore area are well informed and have all their questions answered and have the level of support they need.
