### **OUR APPROACH**

GOAL 1	<ul> <li>High quality and high impact research is funded through an open and transparent funding process.</li> <li>Ensure independent expert review of all Cancer Society research proposals.</li> <li>Assess all Cancer Society research grant applications in a reliable and consistent way.</li> </ul>
GOAL 2	<ul> <li>Cancer Society-funded research projects focus on the priorities of the Society.</li> <li>Review our research priorites on an annual basis.</li> <li>Launch a new funding scheme for a competitive 5 year programme grant.</li> <li>Develop an explicit funding scheme for post-doctoral fellowships.</li> <li>Prioritise funding PhD scholarships in specialty areas, where grant opportunities are limited.</li> </ul>
GOAL 3	<ul> <li>Additional funding is leveraged into cancer research in New Zealand.</li> <li>Seek to establish partnerships with other funding bodies and co-fund high quality cancer research.</li> </ul>
GOAL 4	<ul> <li>National Awareness of the Cancer Society's research programme is increased.</li> <li>Communicate outputs of our research programme to key stakeholders, including the public.</li> <li>Identify opportunities to further increase the profile of the Cancer Society's research programme.</li> </ul>
GOAL 5	<ul> <li>Cancer Society-funded research improves equitable cancer outcomes across the cancer continuum for all New Zealanders.</li> <li>Encourage research applications with a focus on equitable outcomes (such as geography, ethnicity, socioeconomic status, gender).</li> <li>Assess all research proposals on how they will contribute to equitable cancer outcomes.</li> </ul>
GOAL 6	<ul> <li>Commitment to the Treaty of Waitangi is evident throughout the research funding process.</li> <li>Encourage Māori research proposals, as well as involvement of Māori in the design, conduct and dissemination of research (participation).</li> <li>Ensure there is Māori perspective on the decision making panel (partnership).</li> <li>Assess all proposals on how they will contribute to equitable cancer outcomes for Māori (Protection).</li> </ul>
